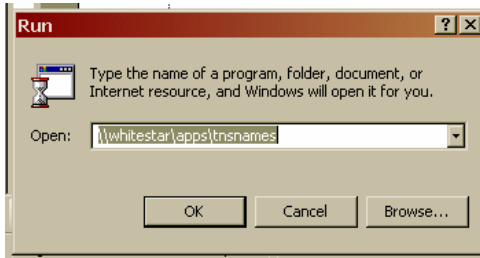


Updating tnsnames.ora file

Make sure that you are logged into the network on your computer.

If you have Windows 2000:

Click on the Start Button in the lower right corner of your PC's desktop.



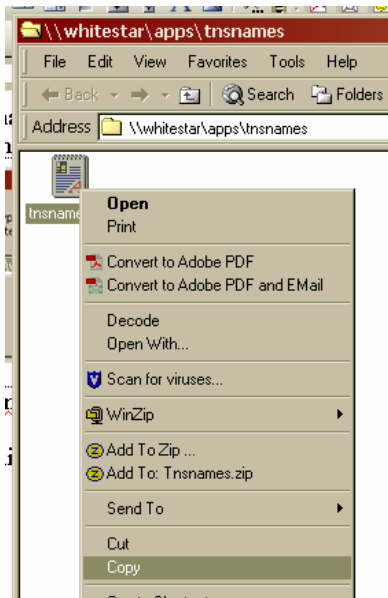
Click on RUN

Type (or copy and paste):

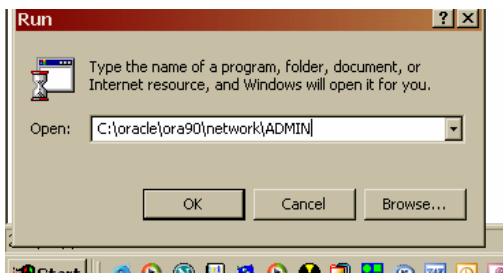
\\whitestar\apps\tnsnames

Click OK.

The tnsnames folder will open.



Right click on the file tnsnames.ora and select copy



Click on the Start Button in the lower right corner of your PC's desktop.

Click on RUN

Type (or copy and paste):

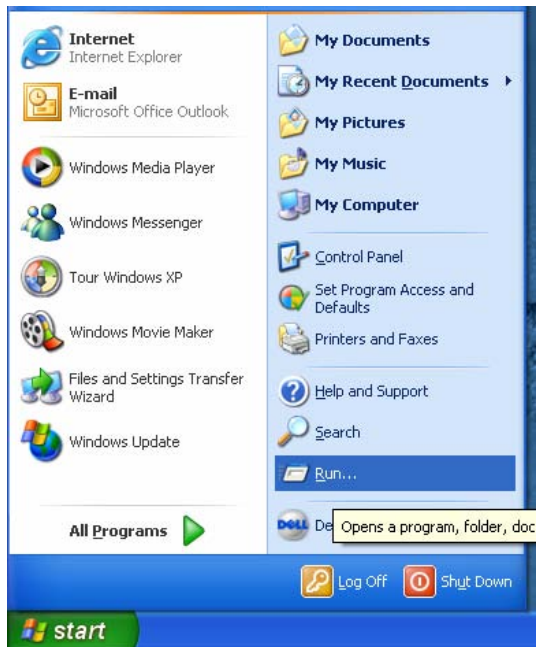
c:\oracle\ora90\network\admin

Click OK.

Once the folder opens, right click in the folder and select paste. Overwrite the existing files.
You have updated your tnsnames file.

If you have windows XP:

The instructions are the same, except the Windows Start/Run box looks a little different:



From this point, follow the instructions for Windows 2000.
