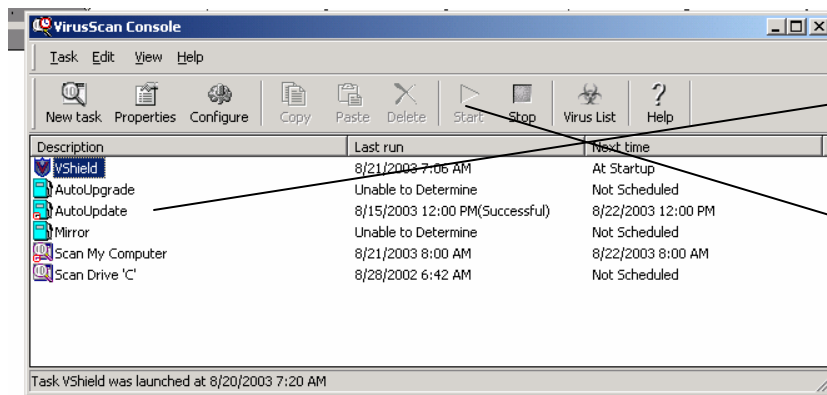
How do I

Virus and worm attacks are a constant threat to the internet and email systems world wide. Security Awareness and aggressive virus defense are the only things that stand between RBC and disaster! When a new virus is released, users may be called upon to update their own virus DAT files. This is a much faster and efficient way to expeditiously update all campus PC'S than waiting for a limited ITS staff to reach a PC...and it is so easy!

Look at the lower right hand corner of your Windows desktop. Do you see a little magnifying glass?



Double-click on the magnifying glass. This opens the Virus Scan Console. If you have a small shield with V, then right click on the shield and select virus scan console from the menu.



Select AutoUpdate by placing your mouse cursor over it and clicking the left mouse button.

Click the Start Button.

If your updates are current, you will receive a message that your dat files are current. Just click OK.

If the dats are not current, they will be automatically updated. When the update is complete Simply close the virus scan console. That's all there is to it!
