Foreign Language¹ (101 and 102 levels do not satisfy this requirement) Spanish or French 201 and 202	201 _____ 202 _____	6	Students must complete the 201 AND 202 levels of the foreign language to fulfill this requirement. The 101 and 102 levels count as elective credits, they DO NOT fulfill this requirement.
Speech 101 or 201 3 credits each	_____	3	Check with your transfer school to determine which course would be most appropriate for you.
Fine Arts Art 201/202/231 or Music 103 or Theater 201 3 credits each	_____	3	Students must complete one semester of a fine art for this requirement. Art 201 and 202, Music 103, and Theater 201 focus on the history of the discipline. No previous artistic background is needed.
Literature (200 level course) or Philosophy or Religion 3 credits each	_____	3	Students must complete one semester of one of these courses to fulfill this requirement. Students must have completed both English 101 and 102 before enrolling in a literature course.
Physical Education² PE 120 2 credits	_____	2	Students must complete one semester of PE 120 to fulfill this requirement.
