


TRANSFER AGREEMENT

OLD DOMINION UNIVERSITY
AND
RICHARD BLAND COLLEGE
of The College of William and Mary


The purpose of this articulation agreement is to assist students at various levels of higher education to achieve their goals in an efficient and timely way. This purpose may be achieved through the coordination between Old Dominion University and Richard Bland College of The College of William and Mary of transfer policies, enhanced advising, and acceptance of equivalent courses. This agreement is in support of the State Policy on Transfer. ODU agrees that Richard Bland College graduates who are accepted under the provision of the State Policy on Transfer will be designated as junior-level students, excepting the provision regarding the transferability of grades lower than C.


1. Upon application, Old Dominion University (ODU) will guarantee acceptance of all Richard Bland College graduates with an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree who have earned a minimum grade point average of 2.2. This guarantee assumes that there are no other factors in a student's academic or personal record that might prevent acceptance. For guaranteed acceptance, applications must be received by August 15 for fall term and October 1 for spring term, and March 15 for summer term. Students with grade point averages below 2.2 but whose last 12 credit hours of transferable credit are 3.0 or above or whose last 24 credit hours are 2.2 or above, or who apply after the stated deadlines also will be considered for admission but without the guaranteed acceptance.
2. Credits earned through examination (Advanced Placement, CLEP, or DANTES) and awarded credit at Richard Bland College will be assessed for transferability by ODU.
3. Richard Bland College graduates may be required to complete any unfulfilled ODU upper-division general education requirements or lower-level college and/or departmental requirements.
4. Acceptance in some programs at ODU is competitive; acceptance into ODU does not imply admission to these programs without further acceptance by the college or department offering the program. Students participating in this admission agreement should follow all special college and/or departmental application procedures and deadlines, as well as grade point requirements listed in the ODU catalog for native ODU students. Transfer students and native ODU students will be treated identically with regard to admission to programs. For example: Dental Hygiene, Medical Technology, Nursing and accelerated bachelor's to master's programs.
5. Richard Bland College graduates transferring to ODU can generally expect to graduate in two years, assuming they take normal course loads, have met the specific prerequisites for their majors, and make satisfactory progress.


6. Students who are not native speakers of English must score at least 550 on the written TOEFL examination or 213 on the computer based examination and have the minimum grade point average of 2.2 in order to be guaranteed admission.
7. All Richard Bland College students will be required to pass ODU's Writing Sample Placement Test prior to registration for their second semester.
8. Students transferring to ODU will have six years from the term of their first enrollment at Richard Bland College to complete degree requirements. Students who do not complete the degree in six years may be required to complete requirements under a subsequent Catalog.
9. ODU will offer accepted applicants from Richard Bland College consideration for available financial aid if they apply for aid by the recommended deadline of May 1 for the fall, October 15 for the spring, and March 15 for summer.
10. The faculty and staff of the two institutions will work together to maintain a course-by-course evaluation of all courses listed in the Richard Bland College Catalog. Richard Bland College faculty and advising staff will encourage prospective ODU transfer students to meet the spirit and content of the ODU general education requirements to the greatest extent possible in preparing for transfer. The College advising coordinators at ODU will offer counsel to Richard Bland College students who plan to transfer to ODU concerning degree requirements and programs of study.
11. Richard Bland College transfer students must sign a *Guaranteed Admission Letter of Intent form* to enroll at ODU.
12. Richard Bland College agrees to support this articulation agreement by indicating the relationship in appropriate literature and through its web site.
13. This agreement may be amended as needed, for specific program articulation without affecting the currency of the master agreement. All course-by-course transfer guides may be amended as needed.
14. This transfer Agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party of an intention to terminate. Such notice shall be effective only if given 180 days prior to the intended date of termination. Upon termination, the agreement will remain in effect for two additional years to accommodate students currently pursuing the articulated program at Richard Bland College.


