Please note that students must have achieved a cumulative 2.5 Grade Point Average during high school to live in the residence halls. There is a non-refundable \$500 down payment that must be submitted upon acceptance into housing. The \$500 down payment secures the room assignment as space permits. The \$500 will be applied toward your room charge, which is **estimated** to be \$4860 per semester for a room in a four-bedroom apartment; \$4980 per semester for a room in a three-bedroom apartment; \$5080 per semester for a room in a two-bedroom apartment, and \$5180 per semester for a single apartment. Down payments and completed applications may be mailed to Office of Residence Life, Richard Bland College, 11301 Johnson Road, Petersburg, VA 23805. Applications may also be faxed to us at (804) 863-1675. Please note that these rates are for the academic year (August 2012-May 2013). Housing assignments will be mailed out in mid-to late-July and will be given priority primarily based upon the date down payments are received, along with the student's high school grade point average (GPA).
