

Wireless Networking and Guest Access

Policy and guidelines

Wireless networking has been deployed throughout the Richard Bland College Library and sections of The Commons. Because of the shared nature of wireless media as well as the security issues surrounding wireless networking, deployment of wireless networks at RBC is co-managed by the RBC Information Technology Services department and the Library. Wireless users must abide by the College's *Acceptable Use Computer Policy* available online at: <http://www.rbc.edu/PDFS/acceptableusepolicy.pdf>. A guest wireless account may be revoked for any violation of these state-mandated and campus policies. Inappropriate guest user behavior on the RBC wireless network may also be subject to sanctions, including the loss of network access privileges, and legal action. Some violations may constitute criminal offenses under local, state, and federal laws. The College will carry out its responsibility to report such violations to the appropriate authorities.

Accessing wireless services

Access to wireless services from the RBC Library and The Commons is available from three Wireless Access Points (WAPs): *RoamAbout LIB1*, *RoamAbout LIB2* and *RoamAbout LIB3*.

Guest access

Authorized guest access is made available at the Library Circulation Desk to users 18 and over. Guests must present photo ID in the form of a valid state driver's license or military ID. Guest accounts expire within a week. Login (authentication) information is not to be shared with others.

Supported operating systems

Wireless access works for Windows, MacOS, and LINUX systems, but the College is able to provide only very limited configuration assistance to non-Windows users.

Cisco Clean Access Agent

Authorized wireless users must download and run Cisco Clean Access Agent on their computers to ensure that their device is running the latest virus software and Windows updates.
