- Go to the library web page at www.rbc.edu/library.
- Click on the **VIVA** button. From the list of VIVA databases, select **Factiva**.

Search terms to consider using for a *Factiva* search include: *biologists, environmentalists, researchers and genetics, scientists, scientists and nutrition, medical researchers, stem cells, science and ethics, biology and research, etc.*
