

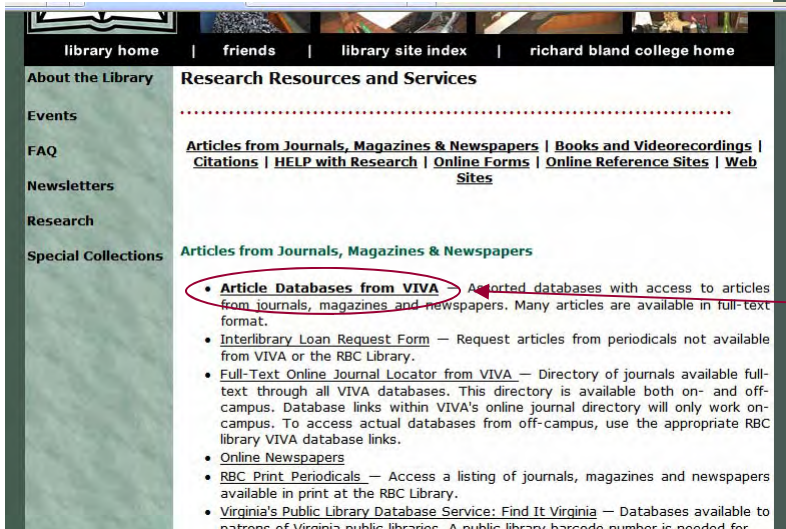
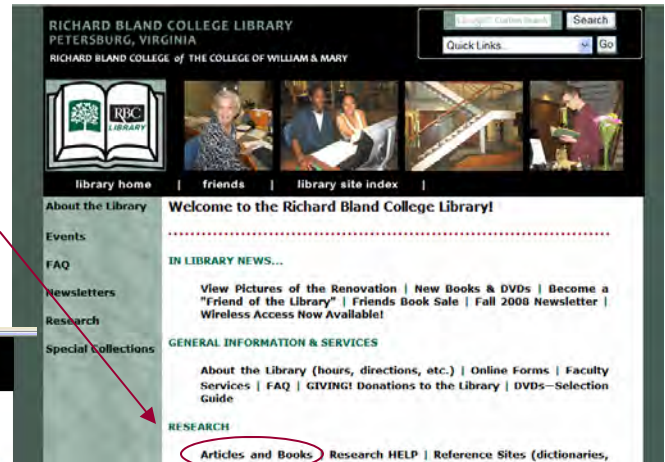

STEP ONE

- Begin at the library web page: www.rbc.edu/library.
- Select **"Articles and Books"** listed under RESEARCH.

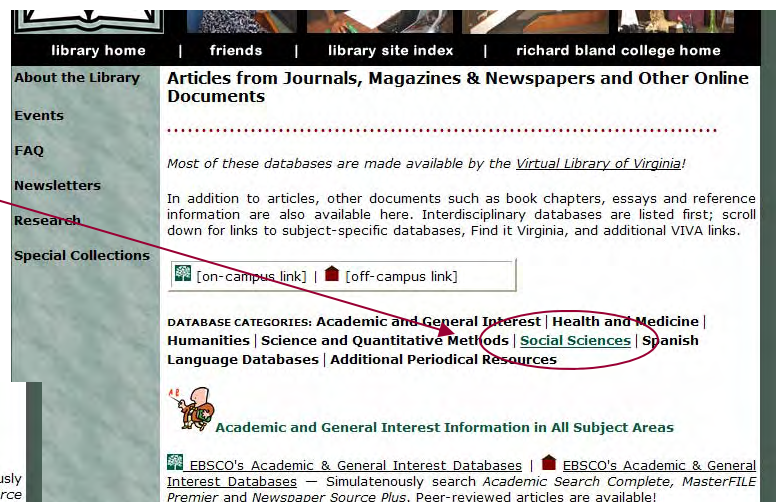


STEP TWO

- Select **"Article Databases from VIVA."**

STEP THREE

- Select **"Social Sciences."**



STEP FOUR

- Select **"EBSCO's Psychology Databases."** Note that there are two links: an on-campus link and an off-campus link. *For the purposes of database access, students in the residence halls are considered off-campus.* Logging in when off-campus is just like logging into Blackboard.



STEP FIVE

- Click **Continue** to begin searching five EBSCO databases simultaneously: *Academic Search Complete*, *Communications & Mass Media Complete*, *PsycARTICLES*, *Psychology and Behavioral Sciences Collection* and *PsycINFO*.

STEP SIX

- Enter search terms.
- Set general search limits. For academic journals, select **Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals**. You can also narrow by date.
- You can also scroll down to set database-specific limits for each of the five databases.
- Click the **Search** button to execute your search.

STEP SEVEN

- View your results. You can click the article title link for more information and options.
- Some articles, like #36, will provide you with a link to the full-text.
- Other articles, like #37, will provide you with an abstract only. If the Library doesn't subscribe to the journal in print form, these articles can be ordered for you via Interlibrary Loan (ILL).
