MISSION

Virginia students meeting Promise Scholar criteria enroll at Richard Bland College where the Exceptional Student Experience[®] program provides a dedicated Learner Mentor and personalized guidance. Promise Scholar candidates engage with William & Mary faculty as first and second year students, ultimately transferring and earning a prestigious William & Mary degree with little or no debt.



FUNDING

Each Promise Scholar will receive:

- Guaranteed 80% coverage of direct costs*
- \$2,000 Promise Scholarship (\$1,000 each semester)
– Promise Scholar requirements must be met to be awarded this scholarship each semester
- \$1,000 Honors Program Scholarship (\$500 each semester) – Honors Program requirements must be met to be awarded this scholarship each semester

* Direct costs include tuition, fees, room and board

REQUIREMENTS

- Desire to attend William & Mary
- Admitted into Richard Bland College
- 3.5+ high school GPA or 3.25+ college GPA
- Virginia resident
- Live on campus at RBC
- Participate in the Honors Program
- Eligible to receive a Pell Grant; must complete a FAFSA (RBC code: 003707)
- Commitment to graduate with an Associate's Degree from RBC regardless of how many credits are brought to RBC
- Attend the entire second year at RBC
- Complete the application process – information, including deadline and application: www.rbc.edu
