    - Online (RBC.edu) or Paper
  - High School Transcript
    - Standard or Advanced Diploma or equivalent classes taken
    - Some students may be asked for midyear or final grades
- **Optional**
  - Test Scores (SAT or ACT)
  - Letter of Recommendation
  - Essay – personal statement

  - High School Transcript
  - College Transcript
  - Dean Certification Form

  - Test Scores (SAT or ACT)
  - Letter of Recommendation
