RBC has been allocated, \$1,589,586 in funding from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III - Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students (HEERF III- ARP).

3. The total amount of HEERF III grants distributed to students.

As of 12/31/2021 - \$1,589,590 has been disbursed to students from this program.

4. The estimated total number of students who are eligible to receive a HEERF III grant.

As of 12/31/2021 – RBC estimates that approximately 1300 students are eligible for HEERF III.

5. The total number of students who have received a HEERF III grant.

As of 12/31/2021 - 1296 students have received a HEERF III grant.

6. The institution used the following method(s) to determine which students received HEERF III grants and how much they would receive.

RBC used the NASFAA Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds Comparison Chart dated March 2021 to determine eligibility. In addition, students who were Pell eligibility were given higher priority based on financial need.

7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the HEERF III grants.

Students were notified of HEERF III grants eligibility, with directions on how to enroll in direct deposit to receive the funds timely, and guidance on how the grant affects upcoming financial aid eligibility. Students were also asked to provide written permission if they wished for the grant to be applied to any remaining student account balance.
