Obtain permission from parent/ guardian and your high school. Homeschool students must submit a copy of the current homeschool agreement /letter from local school

Complete the online dual enrollment application once permission has been granted by your high school.

- DE courses taught at your high

Submit the \$35 application fee.

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment offers college level courses to high school juniors, seniors, and homeschool students that fulfill both high school and college graduation requirements.



- Get a jumpstart on your college degree to reduce time for degree completion
- Earn both high school and college credit concurrently
- Explore career interests and potential areas of study before declaring a major
- Experience the rigor of college coursework while still in high school
- Ability to earn associate degree while in high school
- Lower the total cost of your college degree

Asynchronous vs. Synchronous Learning

Asynchronous learning- allows you to learn on your own schedule, within a certain timeframe. You can access and complete lectures, readings, homework, and other learning materials at any time.

Synchronous learning - attend class virtually each week with instructors and classmates, participate in real-time discussions during class time.

DUAL ENROLLMENT PATHWAYS

- Individual dual enrollment courses
- Passport: 16 credits of coursework which are transferable and satisfy lower-division general education requirements at any Virginia public institution of higher education
- Uniform Certificate of General Studies (UCGS): a one-year college program consisting of 30-32 credits in which all courses are transferable and satisfy lower-division general education requirements at any Virginia public institution of higher education
- Associate degree: 60-62 credits of coursework which are transferable to one of our 35+ transfer
